Position Overview:

The Banner Bags **Distance Education Manager** will deliver the Banner Bags curriculum to schools outside of the Lower Mainland through an online education platform. This role will enable you to collaborate with high school teachers and school board members outside of the Lower Mainland. You will have the opportunity to develop and improve online curriculum components. You will work closely with the Project Manager to plan and execute the strategic expansion of Banner Bags' Distance Education component. This position will allow you to develop leadership, teamwork, and communication skills, as you work to make Banner Bags a part of high school curriculums.

Your term will run from **June 2017 to May 2018.**

Responsibilities:

- Contacting school boards and high school teachers to gain partnerships.
- Pitching Banner Bags to school boards
- Ensure appropriate metrics are being tracked to monitor participant's progress and results
- Continually revise the current curriculum with the Project Manager
- Offer teachers the necessary support to run effective workshops
- Attend weekly meetings and contribute ideas

- Passionate about making an impact in the community and working closely with school boards and high school teachers
- Demonstrate leadership, problem-solving, and organizational skills
- Strong communication skills (verbal and written)
- Exceptional time management skills, with the ability to prioritize and multi-task
